Foundation Awards

Up to six Foundation Awards, valued at up to \$500 each, can be awarded annually towards costs for items approved by the Foundation's Board.

Foundation Awards are given with the purpose of increasing the participation and inclusion of children with disabilities in Island life.

Criteria:

Applicants must have a permanent disability, be aged 19 or under at the time of application and be a permanent resident of PEI. Application forms must be accompanied by two reference letters. Successful applicants for Foundation Awards may re-apply after three years.

The award application deadline is June 30th of each year.

Alice and Roy Bruce Memorial Scholarships

Up to four Scholarships, valued at up to \$500 each, can be awarded annually towards the cost of a post-secondary education at a recognized educational institution.

Criteria:

Applicants must have a permanent disability and be a permanent resident of PEI. Application forms must be accompanied by two reference letters from the most recent educational institution/school attended and proof of acceptance at a post-secondary institution.

The scholarship application deadline is June 30th of each year.

Past successful applicants for Scholarships may not be considered in subsequent years unless there are no sufficient qualified applicants.
